SIMPLE SMOKE RING

Materials: 320 yards of a high halo DK or light worsted weight yarn.
24" circular needle in size 7 (4.5 mm) or size to obtain gauge

Gauge: 5.5 st/in in stockinette

Cast on 120 sts using tubular cast on.

Join, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Work the rest of the tubular cast-on:

Round 1: k1, sl1 wyif; rep to end

Round 2: sl 1 wyib, p1; rep to end

Rounds 3 & 4, repeat rounds 1 & 2

Round 5: yo, k20g; repeat

Repeat round 5 until cowl is 11" from cast on row.

Tubular Cast off:

Round 1: sl 1 wyib, p1; rep to end (note, the stitches you are slipping were yo's)

Round 2: k1, sl1 wyif; rep to end

Repeat these two rounds,

Weave edges with kitchener stitch, assuming all knit stitches are the front needle and purls are the back.

Optional:

For a decorative edging, work 7 inches as above, then 2 inches in a contrasting color, followed by one inch as above.

Slip over your head and enjoy!
